

1. NOTICES TO PROPERTY OWNER

If bills are not paid in full for the labor, services, equipment, or materials furnished or to be furnished, a mechanic's lien leading to the loss, through court foreclosure proceedings of all or part of your property being so improved may be placed against the property even though you have paid your contractor in full. 2. FEDERAL TRUTH IN LENDING ACT
